


Presentation of Latvia and Turiba University by Ineta Luka





Presenting the prepared online teaching modules in 6 languages Ineta Luka, Head of the Department of Languages of Turiba University, presented the prepared online teaching modules in LV, RU, EN, ES, FR and GE. Each material consists of several topics.




The modules have been created taking into consideration the useful topics for developing language skills and improving the existing language skills. The materials cover the following language levels – A1 for LV, RU, ES, FR and GE and A2-B1 for EN. One module that contains useful lexis and tasks for everyday communication has been developed for every target language – 'Restaurants' for FR, ES, RU, 'Hotels' for GE.

As EN is the most popular and required foreign language to find employment, 12 modules have been created for developing EN language competence.




Turiba University has many foreign students who want to learn some basic LV and RU, therefore the LV course contains 4 basic modules regarding everyday situations – 'Transport', 'Shopping', 'Restaurants', 'Medicine'. An additional module on Russian culture has been created.

As the focus of the project is also on intercultural competence, the modules comprising texts and tasks revealing the specific traditions and culture of the six languages – LV, RU, EN, ES, FR, GE have been created.



To learn the topic, it is possible to perform interactive multiple-choice, short-answer, jumbled-sentence, crossword, matching/ordering and gap-fill exercises.





Presentation of foreign language exams for adults in Latvia by

Ineta Luka

Ineta Luka explained basic information about foreign language exams for adults in Latvia. In grade 12 (secondary school) English is the compulsory exam, second language (German, French, Russian) – optional exam. Exam consists of 5 parts – reading, listening, language use, writing and speaking. In Non-formal education there are Latvian language exams organized by 2 institutions. The most popular international exams in Latvia in:

- English are TOIEC, TOEFL, IELTS, ACT, SAT I and II, GRE, GMAT and Cambridge Certificate tests;
- German Fit in Deutsch 1, Start Deutsch 1, Zertifikat Deutsch für Jugendliche ,Zertifikat Deutsch, Zertifikat Deutsch für den Beruf ,Goethe-Zertifikat B2, Test Deutsch als Fremdsprache, Prüfung Wirtschaftsdeutsch, Goethe-Zertifikat C1,Test Deutsch als Fremdsprache and Goethe-Zertifikat C2, Großes Deutsches Sprachdiplom;
- Russian ECL certification and TORFL;
- French TCF, DELF and DALF;
- Spanish DELE.

The meeting participants were presented a CD with the reports on language exams in Latvia, including the test examples in EN, GE, FR. 
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Liga Klavina, language teacher, presented how she teaches the Latvian language for foreign students. The topic of the theme was "Café and Restaurant", the aim – to master the vocabulary. Used methods – visual, inductive and dialogical methods. One of the parts of lesson was practice in a café.



 Liga Klavina also presented one lecture in French. The aim was to master the use of the adjectives that are connected with the topic "Food" and to use the vocabulary acquired in practice.





 Sandra Smilga, language teacher, presented a game created by herself in the Russian language. The aim of this game is to revise all topics for the exam. The target group is Level A1 students. The title of the game "Money, money, money".



 Anda Komarovska, language teacher, presented one English language lecture for tourism students about trends in tourism in the world and Latvia. The aim is to introduce the students to new trends of tourism in the world and Latvia, and the vocabulary related.





 Anita Emse, language teacher, presented one lecture in German on the theme "Terminvereinbarung" – appointment. The audience took active part in singing a song "Wann wollen wir und treffen? ".

Ineta Luka presented the main information about Turiba University electronic record system for lecturers. In this system lecturer can find all information about study tasks, course programmes, students list and their marks. 

7. Summary of results

The third project meeting in Riga was a joint mobility meeting to the Baltic states – Latvia (Turiba University) and Lithuania (Vilnius Business College) therefore the meeting agenda was coordinated and worked out together by the contact persons of both institutions - Ineta Luka and Deimante Vilcinskaite. As the total length of the mobility was 7 days arrival to Riga on May 27, transfer Riga-Vilnius on May 30 and departure on June 2, it resulted in 2 full working days in Riga. Therefore, the agenda was planned in a way so that it would give an opportunity to cover the work at the project (presentations on the work performed, demonstration of language learning systems and exams in the country, demonstration of innovative teaching/learning methods and tools, etc.) and to see the highlights of Riga City. In order to cover all the aspects, the work was arranged that the participants worked at Turiba University premises on May 28 and on May 29 a field trip and other excursions were organized. The work was split between Turiba University and Vilinius Business College and at Turiba University the participants discussed the details about the midterm report, whereas at Vilnius Business College more attention to the project website and dissemination was paid.
